The Northampton Survival Center is pleased to offer our Kids' Summer Food Program to eligible children through our food pantries in Northampton and Goshen. This program provides free groceries throughout summer vacation. To be eligible for this program, children must live in one of the towns in our service area (listed on the left) and families must meet our income guidelines which can be found on our website. Eligible children range in age from those who have just completed kindergarten to those starting 12th grade in the fall of 2023.

Beginning in June, eligible families may pick up food from this program in addition to the food they may already be collecting for the family from our pantry. As they select an assortment of groceries for the household, families of school-age children will select additional grocery items for their kids, including grains, protein, dairy items, fresh produce, and canned fruits and vegetables.
